Polyester Taffeta

Polyester taffeta is a smooth, crisp, lightweight fabric commonly used for linings in jackets, coats, dresses, skirts, and bags. It gives structure, reduces friction, and helps garments glide comfortably when worn. It's durable, wrinkle-resistant, and easy to maintain.

Care Instructions

- Machine wash on **cold** using a gentle or delicate cycle.
- Use **mild detergent** — avoid bleach and harsh chemicals.
- Turn the garment **inside out** before washing to protect the taffeta.
- Do not wring; gently press out excess water.
- **Air dry** for best results, or tumble dry on **low heat** only.
- **If ironing is needed, use low heat and a pressing cloth — polyester melts under high heat.**
- Avoid dryers on high heat, radiators, or direct sunlight while drying.

Important Notes for Polyester Taffeta

- High heat can cause the fabric to **shrink, warp, or melt** — always use **low temperatures**.
- Avoid sharp objects, as taffeta can snag easily.
- Store garments with polyester taffeta in a cool, dry place.
- Hanging coats or jackets with taffeta linings helps maintain the shape of both the garment and the lining.
- If the lining becomes wrinkled, use **steam from a distance** or a **low iron** on the reverse side with a cloth on top.
