Taffeta Lining

Taffeta lining is a smooth, crisp, lightweight fabric often used inside coats, jackets, dresses, and bags. It adds structure, helps garments glide easily over clothing, and gives a polished, high-quality finish. Taffeta can be made from polyester, nylon, acetate, or silk.

Care Instructions

- Machine wash on **cold** using a gentle cycle (polyester/nylon taffeta).
- For acetate or delicate taffeta, **hand wash cold** or **dry clean** only.
- Use **mild detergent** — avoid bleach and harsh chemicals.
- Do not wring; gently press out water.
- **Air dry** for best results; avoid the dryer for delicate types.
- If needed, iron using low heat on the reverse side (place a cloth on top).
- Never use high heat — it can melt or damage the fibers.

- Smooth and comfortable against the skin

Important Notes for Taffeta Lining

- Taffeta is sensitive to heat — always use **low temperatures** when washing or ironing.
- Avoid sharp objects that can snag or pull the smooth surface.
- If the lining is **silk taffeta**, dry cleaning is the safest option.
- Store garments with taffeta lining in a cool, dry place to prevent wrinkles and moisture damage.
- Hanging garments with taffeta linings helps maintain their shape.
