Tweed

Tweed is a classic, textured fabric traditionally made from wool. It's warm, durable, and known for its beautiful woven patterns and rustic feel. Proper care helps tweed keep its shape and structure for many years.

Care Instructions

- **Dry clean only** for best results — tweed is a structured fabric and can lose shape in water.
- If spot cleaning is needed, use a **damp cloth** with mild soap to gently blot the stain (do not rub).
- Allow to **air dry naturally**; avoid heaters, radiators, and direct sunlight.
- Brush gently with a **soft fabric brush** to remove surface dust and maintain texture.
- If ironing is needed, use **low to medium heat** with a pressing cloth on top
- Never machine wash or tumble dry tweed — it may shrink or warp

Important Notes for Tweed

- Store tweed garments on a **padded hanger** to maintain shape.
- Avoid crushing the fabric — give tweed room to breathe in the closet.
- Tweed is naturally durable, but avoid snagging on sharp objects.
- Use cedar or lavender sachets when storing to keep moths away.
